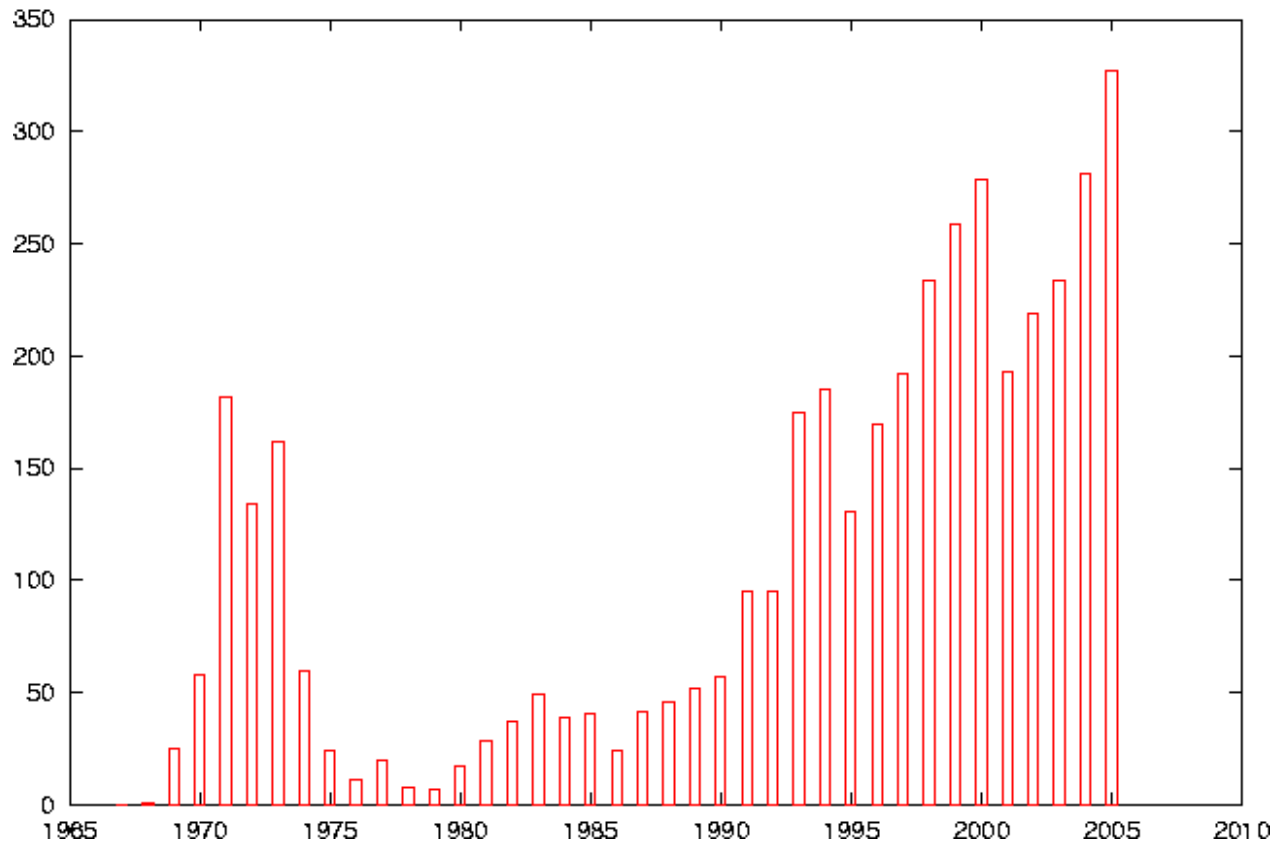

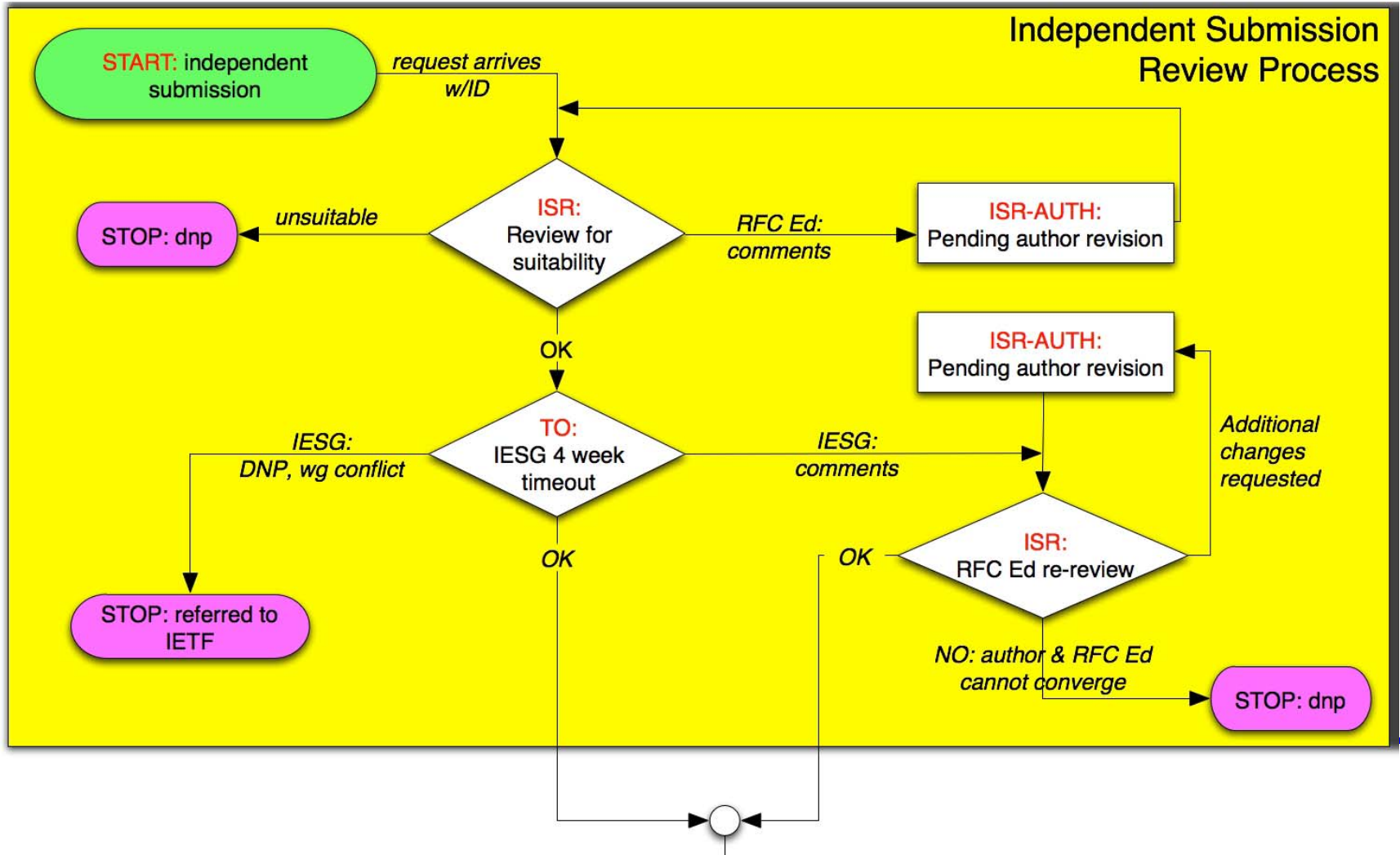

# Publication Process

**START: IETF submission**

*IESG: protocol / document action*

**START: IAB submission**

*request arrives w/ ID*

**MISSREF:** wait to receive normative references

**IANA:** registry creation

**EDIT:** nroff, grammar, spelling

**AUTH:** fix

**REF:** waiting for normative references

**RFC EDITOR:** final review

**STOP:** withdrawn

assign RFC #

**AUTH 48:** authors review ("48 hours")

**AUTH:** fix

**PUBLISH**

**STATES:**  
*AUTH* = holding for author action  
*AUTH48* = "authors 48 hours" final review  
*EDIT* = approved by IESG, awaiting processing  
*IANA* = RFC-Editor/IANA registration coordination  
*IESG* = holding for IESG action  
*ISR* = Independent Submission Review  
*ISR-AUTH* = revisions based on ISR feedback  
*REF* = holding for normative reference  
*RFC-EDITOR* = pending RFC Editor review
